How to Use Your OneCard Gator Pass



What is my Gator Pass?

- Your Gator Pass is a transit pass that allows you to commute to campus (and anywhere else you like) on public transportation.
- As August 26th, 2024, your Gator Pass now provides unlimited rides on **all** Clipper transits including Muni, BART, Caltrain, SamTrans, AC Transit, Golden Gate Transit, ferries, and more during the fall and spring semesters.
- Gator Pass is funded by student fees, each student pays \$130/semester (decreased from \$180 in fall 2024).

Where is my Gator Pass?

It is located on your **OneCard**, which also acts as your student ID, university library card, and more.



Where can I use my Gator Pass?

You get unlimited rides at no cost on **all** Clipper public transits to any stop. Including:


- Muni
- BART
- Caltrain
- SamTrans
- Golden Gate Transit
- AC Transit
- Ferries
- And more!

Conditions

- Activate your Gator Pass online before use (onecard.sfsu.edu).
- Gator Pass is valid everyday of the fall and spring semesters, but not during winter or summer break.
- You must be signed up for classes and pay all tuition/fees before your Gator Pass is activated for the semester.
- If you scan your card and it say "insufficient funds" it means you have not paid your tuition/fees or did not activate your Gator Pass.

How do I use public transportation?

The Google Maps or Transit apps on your phone will tell you different routes you can take and gives you an estimate on when the next transit will arrive.



Just hop on a transit, scan your OneCard, and ride!




Request your stop


Follow your route on your phone. When you see your stop approaching, request a stop by **pressing a stop** request button or pulling the cord.




Take transit anywhere you want!
